

Handbook for Participants of JapanJuniorOpen2019

Precautions for Using the Facility

- Both players and observers must wear indoor footwear inside the venues.
- Please take your own precautions to avoid catching viruses.
- In case you wish to withdraw from the event, please contact the tournament offices as soon as possible.

The venue opens at 8:30am on the 12th, and 7:30am on the rest of the days. Courts are free to use till 5 minutes before the first match of the day. Please take turns and warm up together.

- Please be aware that lost & found items will be disposed after 1 week from the tournament.
- No food or drink is allowed in the venue except in the designated area for keeping the facilities clean. Dispose your trash separately according to the directions at the venue.
- Please follow the rules and instruction of the venue and staff.
- There is no parking lot available. Use the public parking nearby.

Precautions during Matches

- If you are not in the court 15 minutes after your match time, you will forfeit the match.
- Please stand by the court when the previous game of yours is being played. Your match may be followed as soon as the previous one is over.
- In the main draw, the matches will be played “best of 5” games with “PER11” tie-break system. All the plate matches will be played “best of 3” games.
- Please be a Referee (winner) or a Marker (loser) after your match. (In case you are not available, find an alternative person. Only if no alternative is found, contact the staff.)
- 4-minute warm-ups will be allowed before 5 games matches and 3- minute for 3 games matches. (Although the official warm-up time is 4 minutes.)
- Players must wear eye-guards approved by WSF during matches.
- Player who withdraws from the main draw are not eligible to play in plate rounds.
- Player who withdraws from the event in any stage will NOT receive AJSS ranking points.
- The venue may be hot, so please be aware and pay attention to your water intake.
- In the draw, you will see the number of each match within each category.

Plate Matches

- Plate matches will be played differently depending on the category. Please check the draw.
- There may be no positioning round or plate finals depending on a category.

Award Ceremony

- The ceremony will be immediately after the finals on the 15th.
- ⊖ A player who finished the 1st to the 3rd place in each category are to be awarded.

Notification from JSA PR Committee

We will take photos during the tournament only for the purposes of PR activities of Japan Squash Association (JSA) as the party holding the right of likeness. If any players do not wish their photos to be on JSA website or affiliated SNS, please contact a tournament official.

Personal photo-taking and video-taking

Please keep good manners and extra caution for taking photos and using the images.
