<Venue>

*All players and observers must **change to indoor shoes** or slipper inside the venue.(Please keep your outside shoes by yourself.)

*We might limited the number of people who can stay at the venue to avoid crowds.

*Please be aware that lost & found items will be disposed after one week.

*No food or drink is allowed in the venue except in the designated area for keeping the facilities clean.

*Dispose your trash separately according to the directions at the venue.

*Please follow the rules and instructions of the venue and staff.

*Match will be follow on bases. Please stay near by the court when the previous game is being played.

*In the main draw and third-place matches, the matches will be played "best of 5" games with "PER11" tie-break system. Plate matches will be played "best of 3" games.

*Please do a Referee and a Marker after your match. (In case you are not available, please find an alternative person.)

*All players must wear eye-guards approved by WSF during practice & match.

*Player who withdraw from the main draw are not eligible to play in plate match.

*Player who withdraw from the event in any stage will NOT receive AJSS ranking points.

*The number marked on the draw is the match control number.

* Court numbers will be marked on the draw for this tournament. Please note that there will be no match-by-match progression information at the venue. Please be in front of your scheduled court before your match. If there is a change of court, an announcement will be made from the headquarters.

*Plate matches will be played differently depending on the category as follows:

GU11, GU17, GU19 \Rightarrow Players eliminated in the first and second rounds

Other categories \Rightarrow There is a first round loser plate and a second round loser plate.

In all categories except GU19, quarter-final losers will have to play for a place.
