

MARIGOLD SINGAPORE SQUASH CHAMPIONSHIPS 2026

TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

1. Tournament Details

- 1.1 **Date:** 7 – 12 July 2026 (Tues – Sun)
- 1.2 **Time:** Weekdays **4:00 – 10:00 PM**
- 1.3 **Time:** Weekends **10:00 – 6:00 PM**
- 1.4 **Location:** ActiveSG Kallang Squash Centre (8 Stadium Boulevard, 397804)

Note: All players are expected to start their matches at 4:00 PM. If you require a later start time at 6:00 PM (MAX), please indicate this clearly in the Remarks section in Tournament Software during registration.

2. Categories and Cut-Off Dates

National Championships – Open only to Singaporeans

- Men's Open (Max 16 entries)
- Women's Open (Max 16 entries)

Notes:

**Open participants are not allowed to play a second event.*

Above events are registered as PSA Federation events. Players with PSA memberships may claim for points.

If there are more than 16 entries per category, players with the highest Squash Levels will be prioritised.

Local Events – Open to all Singapore Residents (Singaporeans, Long Term Pass Holders)

- Men's Division 1 (Open to Participants with SquashLevels level $\geq 2000^*$)
- Men's Division 2 (Open to Participants with SquashLevels level $< 2000^*$)
- Men's Division 3 (Open to Participants with SquashLevels level $< 1000^*$)
- Women's Division 1 (Open to Female Participants with SquashLevels level $\geq 500^*$)
- Women's Division 2 (Open to Female Participants with SquashLevels level $< 500^*$)
- Men's Masters I (Born 1986 or earlier)
- Men's Master's II (Born 1976 or earlier)
- Men's Novice (Open to Participants with SquashLevels level $< 200^*$)
- Women's Novice (Open to Participants with SquashLevels level $< 200^*$)

The cut-off date for **ALL** events is **12 July 2026**.

3. Entry Eligibility

- 3.1 The tournament is open to all residents in Singapore and invited foreign guests.
- 3.2 SSRA membership is required for all SSRA organised events.
- 3.3 **Children under the age of 12 are exempted** as SSRA membership is only open to those aged 12 and above.
- 3.4 SSRA membership can be applied here: [2026 SSRA Individual Membership Form](#).
- 3.5 All entries without SSRA membership will not be refunded.
- 3.6 Players may compete in up to two (2) categories, subject to availability.
- 3.7 Players entering two categories may be required to play back-to-back matches.

4. Entry Details, Deadline & Withdrawals

- 4.1 **SGD 40** Entry fee per category (includes tournament t-shirt)
- 4.2 Entries must be received with payment via the online entry form by **12 June 2026 (2359 Singapore Time)**.
- 4.3 All entries are to be done via **Tournament Software**, and payment must be made with **PayPal** at the point of registration. Refer to: <https://bit.ly/MARIGOLDSingaporeSquashChampionships2026>
- 4.4 Players may withdraw **within 48 hours after the entry closing date**. After this deadline, players listed in the entry list are deemed committed to the tournament.
- 4.5 **No refunds for late withdrawals (48 hours after entries close) will be given.**
- 4.6 Late withdrawals will only be accepted if supported by:
 - 4.6.1 Medical certificates, or
 - 4.6.2 National representation commitments.
 - 4.6.3 Other official documentation such as signed school letters.

*All cases are subject to approval by **Singapore Squash**.
- 4.7 A category must have a **minimum of 8 players** to be opened. If the minimum number is not met, the organizer may:
 - 4.7.1 Combine the category with a higher division, or
 - 4.7.2 Remove the category.

*Singapore Squash reserves the right to **reject entries if it is required to have a better draw size**.

Where necessary, entries may be removed on a **Last-In-First-Out (LIFO)** basis to achieve draw sizes in **multiples of eight**.

5. Tournament Format

- 5.1 All main draw and top 8 position matches will be played to the best of 5 games.
- 5.2 All other matches will be either best of 5 or best of 3 subjected to court availability and at the discretion of Singapore Squash.
- 5.3 11 points – PAR (Point-A-Rally) following the WSF Rules of World Singles Game.
- 5.4 The **17-inch** tin height will be used for all the categories.
- 5.5 **Circuit/Monrad Format will be used, whereby all players continue to play, win or lose through to a final finishing position.** However, this is subject to change depending on the number of entries and court time availability at the discretion of Singapore Squash.
- 5.6 Dunlop Double Yellow Dot Balls will be used during the Tournament.
- 5.7 Eyewear is mandatory for all juniors under the age of 19.
- 5.8 For all others, eyewear is not mandatory but strongly encouraged. **The tournament requires the full commitment of a player to complete all his/her matches. Players who are uncertain of their schedule are encouraged not to sign up to avoid any disruptions to the fixtures.**

6. Seeding

- 6.1 SquashLevels (www.squashlevels.com) will be the basis for seeding.
- 6.2 Seedings will be based on Squash Levels rankings as of **25 May 2026**.
- 6.3 Seeding will be done in the following manner 1st, 2nd, Joint 3/4, Joint 5/8, 9/16.
- 6.4 Draws will be generated using the **Tournament Software platform**.

7. Tournament Schedules

- 7.1 Players are to **register 45 minutes before their scheduled match**. Match timing is an indication only. Matches will be played on a **FOLLOW-ON-BASIS**.
- 7.2 A walkover will be awarded against players who do not show up after **10 minutes** from the time their names are called; subsequent matches will be forfeited.
- 7.3 No matches are to be rescheduled unless with permission from the Tournament Director. **Rescheduling of final position matches (1st to 8th place) for prizes will not be entertained.**
- 7.4 All walkovers should be informed via events@sgsquash.com, before their scheduled match time. Walkovers without prior notice may be subjected to a ban (up to 1 year from all Singapore Squash organized/supported events).
- 7.5 **After a walkover is given, all further matches will be forfeited.**

8. No-Show Policy

8.1 Players who fail to appear without notice will be: Subjected to possible disciplinary action and may be blacklisted.

*Appeals must be submitted in writing.

8.2 Blacklist penalties may include:

8.2.1 Up to **6 months suspension**, or

8.2.2 Exclusion from the **next three SSRA events**.

8.3 Unsubstantiated withdrawals may result in:

8.3.1 Suspension or ban from future SSRA events.

9. Prize Ceremony

9.1 Prize ceremony will be held for the top eight winners (min 16 draws) and top four for less than (8 draws) of each category.

9.2 Medals will be awarded for places 5-8 for categories with a minimum of 16 participants in the draw.

9.3 The awards ceremony will be held immediately after the Men's Open final, for the Top four/eight winners in each category.

9.4 Cash prizes will also be awarded to the top four winners of the divisions listed in the table below if there is a minimum of 16 participants in the draw, except for Men's Masters - min 8 participants. Singapore Squash reserves the right to alter the cash prizes structure in the event there are less than 16 participants in the draw. The breakdown of cash prizes is as follow:

*Prize monies apply to both genders unless stated

9.5 Cash prize winners, if applicable, are to proceed to the tournament control and provide bank details for payment of their prize monies.

9.6 **All prize recipients are required to be in the tournament T-Shirt and covered shoes.**

9.7 **Winners who are not present for the prize-giving ceremony will have their prizes forfeited.**

Others

- **Players will be required to referee matches, and it is compulsory.** Players who refuse to do so may be disqualified.
- Singapore Squash reserves the right to interpret or amend the rules and regulations and handbook of the tournament at any time.
- While reasonable precautions will be taken, the Singapore Squash, its servants and its agents will not be responsible or in any way liable for any death, disability, personal injury, loss of property or any other loss howsoever arising from any cause whatsoever at any time during the course of this tournament.
