Categories

Boys & Girls: Under 11, 13, 15, 17, 19

- Participants are only allowed to register for one (1) event and will be **guaranteed a minimum of 2 matches**.

WSF & PSA National Junior Open

- The Boys and Girls Under-17 and 19 events are registered as a WSF & PSA National Junior Open.
- Participants with a valid PSA membership may claim PSA points, subject to a minimum draw of 16 players.

Age Cut-off Date

13 December 2026 for all age groups.

Entry Closing Date

- **20 October 2026, 11.59pm Singapore Time.**
- Late entries or entries without fees will not be accepted.

Entry Requirements

- Open to all foreign and local players not banned by WSF, ASF and/or SSRA.
- Please provide your correct date of birth. They will be verified from your passport and/or NRIC.
- All participants must have a WSF SPIN. You may register for a WSF SPIN (fee involved) at <https://www.worldsquash.sport/spins/>. Entries without SPIN will be rejected.

Scoring & Format

- Tournament format will be determined by the organiser depending on the draw size.
- Scoring - 11 points – PAR (Point-A-Rally) following the WSF Singles Rules.

Daily Check-In at venue

- Players must check-in 45 minutes before their scheduled match time. Match timing is an indication only. Matches will be played on a **FOLLOW-ON-BASIS** (matches will be called to start when the preceding match ends, participants are expected to play up to 30 minutes before scheduled time). **Postponement of matches will not be entertained.**
- A walkover will be awarded against participants who are more than **15 minutes late upon being called to start the match**; subsequent matches will be forfeited; no AJSS points and rankings will be awarded unless a valid MC is produced and notice is given to the organiser prior to the start of the match.
- Participants will be expected to play up to two matches a day.

Practice Courts (for Foreign Participants Only)

Practice courts will be available on 7 December 2026 (Monday) from 11am – 7pm, subject to venue availability. Allocation is on a first come first serve basis. The organiser has the right to alter and limit the allocated times at any time to ensure that everyone can practice. Please book considerably. Tournament T-shirt

- All participants will receive a tournament T-shirt.
- Do specify your t-shirt size correctly. XXXS (32") to XXL (46"). Size in chest inches.
- No exchange of t-shirt sizes will be entertained.

Official Ball & Eye Wear

- Dunlop Pro Squash Balls will be used during the Tournament.
- WSF Certified Eyewear is mandatory for all participants.

Prize Money & Prizes

- Prize presentation will be held on 13 December 2026 (Sunday) immediately after the BU19 final.
- It is mandatory for prize winners to be **present personally** for the prize presentation ceremony **in the tournament t-shirt** to receive their prizes. No slippers and sandals are allowed.
- Prizes, medals, or prize monies will be forfeited if it is not collected during the prize presentation ceremony.
- Prize monies will be paid for U17 and U19 categories, with equal amounts for both genders. Prize monies will only be paid with a **minimum of eight (8) participants** in the draw.

*Medals for 5-8 will only be awarded with a minimum sixteen (16) participants in the draw.

Entry Withdrawal

- You must notify singaporejunioropen.ssra@gmail.com of any withdrawal with valid reasons. Entry fees **will not be refunded** if withdrawal is done after the closing date (**20 October 2026**).
- Paid up entry fee is non-transferable between participants.
- **Late withdrawal.** Withdrawal after the closing date will be considered a 'late withdrawal'. All late withdrawals must be accompanied by a Medical Certificate (MC) or any official documentation, subject to the approval of the Organiser. Failing to do so will result in the participant scoring 'ZERO' AJSS ranking points which will be reflected as one of the participant's best 4 results. For those who produce the MC or official documentation, ASF will evaluate each withdrawal on a case-by-case basis. All late withdrawals will not be refunded – entry fee and tournament hotel package inclusive.

Code of Conduct

All individuals attending and/or participating in the event, conducted under SSRA auspices e.g. players, parents, referees, officials, trainers, coaches or other person connected with a participating player or team, or other involved person, are to comply with the SSRA Code of conduct (https://bit.ly/SSRA_CODE_OF_CONDUCT)

The Organising Team will not tolerate any form of abuse, harassment or disrespectful behaviour towards event personnel by players, parents, coaches or supporters. All incidents of inappropriate or unacceptable conduct will be taken seriously and dealt with accordingly.

ASF Seeding Rules

Seeding (ASF Rule JD8) The seeding will be solely carried out by the host MNA. It is recommended that the Asian Junior Ranking valid at the closing date shall be used as a primary reference for seeding purpose. In addition, World Junior Ranking, PSA ranking are also recommended to be taken into consideration if appropriate. Players who opt to play in higher age categories can carry 50% of the ranking points of their own age category for seeding purpose at the discretion of the host MNA.

ONCOCARE Singapore Junior Open 2026 Seeding Rule Considerations

- All appeals must come through MNAs. Individual appeals will not be entertained.
- Asian Junior Ranking shall be used as the first basis for seeding.
- Certain concessions may be given to National Top 2 ranked players from non ASF countries.
- Head-to-head wins will not be taken into consideration for Appeal of seeding.
- SquashLevels will be used as an additional reference.

Other Notes

- The Organisation Team reserves the right to interpret or amend the rules and regulations of the tournament at any time. Notification of such changes will be emailed to participants. All participants are advised to check their email frequently for any announcements or changes to draws/schedules.
- The Organisation Team will, in their best effort, deconflict players of the same nation in the opening round. Subsequent rounds will be randomly drawn by the system.
- While reasonable precautions will be taken, the Singapore Squash Rackets Association and Team Ultimate Squasher Pte Ltd, its officials and agents will not be responsible or in any way liable for any death, disability, personal injury, loss of property or any other loss howsoever arising from any cause whatsoever at any time during this tournament.
